The 134<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar was celebrated with great enthusiasm and reverence at Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur. To honour the legacy of one of India's greatest social reformers, jurists, and architects of the Indian Constitution, the college organized a week-long series of events across all faculties. The celebrations were centred on themes of education, social justice, constitutional values, scientific thinking, and the promotion of equality, which reflect the life and mission of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar.

The multi-disciplinary events conducted by the faculty of Humanities, Science, Commerce and Law brought students and faculty together in meaningful dialogue, academic exploration. Each event was designed to connect Dr. Ambedkar's thoughts with contemporary issues. The events were initiated to highlight Dr. Ambedkar's contribution in the shaping of today's socio-political and educational context.

#### **Faculty of Law:**

**Title of the Program:** A Round Table Dialogue Titled "Vision And Ideals That Shape India"

To commemorate the 134<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of Dr. B. R Ambedkar, a round table dialogue titled "**Vision and Ideals that Shape India**" was organized on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 at 11.30 AM. The event aimed to reflect on Dr. Ambedkar's ideals in the making of Modern India. The event was organised to foster a collaborative dialogue between faculty and students. The program was supervised by Dr. V.V. Deshpande and Dr. V.A. Sukhdeve. The total number of participants was 20. Dr. Varsha Deshpande, professor and Head of the Department of Law, delivered her inaugural address and threw lights on Dr. Ambedkar's life and his pivotal role in drafting the Constitution. She emphasised his advocacy for liberty, equality and fraternity.

#### **Students Presentation:**

Mr. Amol Ghotekar, LLB 6<sup>th</sup> SEM, highlighted Dr. Ambedkar's focus on education as a tool empowerment for marginalised communities. Mr. Sarvesh, LLB 6<sup>th</sup> SEM, Kumar supported this view with references to relevant constitutional articles and quoted the

moral role of education. Ms. Linta Thomson, LLB 6<sup>th</sup> SEM, related the ideas of Dr Ambedkar in today's digital era. She gave the examples of digital platforms such as SWAYAM, e-Pathshala and so on which are upholding the values of Dr Ambedkar by providing education to the unreachable and under-privileged sections of the society. It is observed that The New Education Policy also reflects visions of Dr Ambedkar in empowering minds of the young.

### **Faculty remarks:**

Dr. Pratima Lokhande appreciated the students' engagement and reiterated the relevance of Dr. Ambedkar's thoughts in today's socio-political context.

Lastly, Mr Akash Dhote contributed to the discussion by elaborating the use of AI to gain more information. He mentioned that when asked to one of the AI applications – How would Dr Ambedkar react to the current socio-political environment in India? The answer was astonishing because India is the only country in the world that values its minorities and it is the uniqueness of India that unity prevails despite existing in a varied diverse culture of different languages, customs and lifestyles.

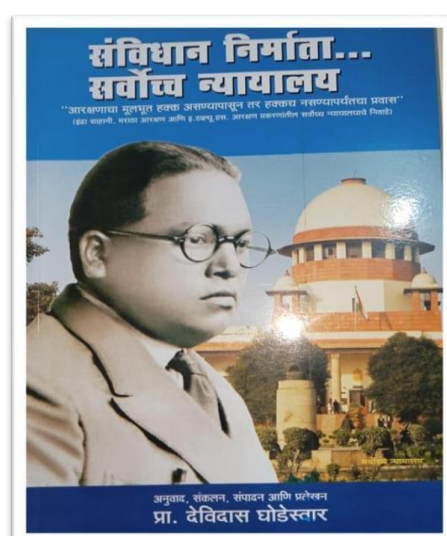
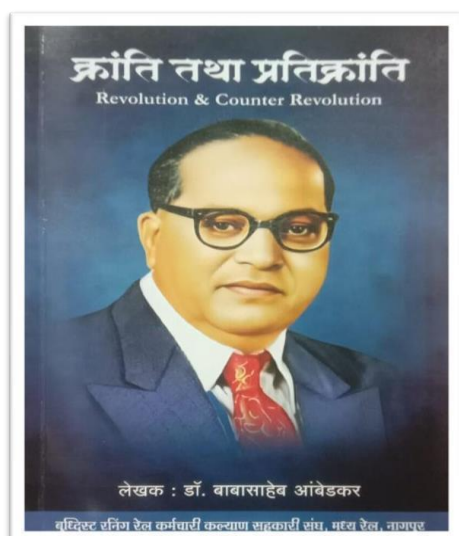

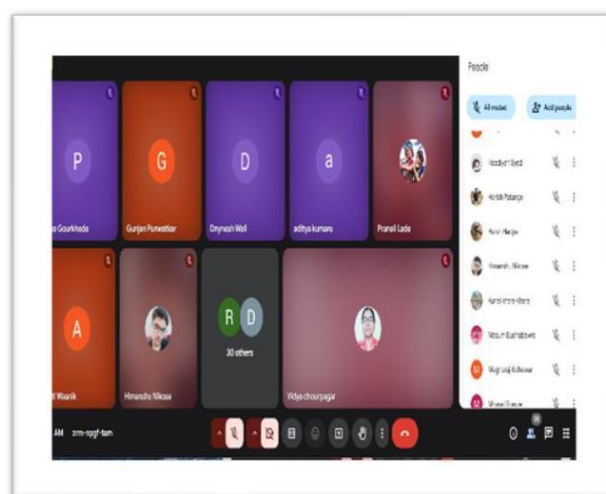

A special educational visit to Deekshabhoomi — a place of profound historical and spiritual significance — was organized to help students understand the monumental event where Dr. Ambedkar embraced Buddhism along with thousands of followers. Students were welcomed by site guides and taken through the Stupa, museum, and the Bodhi tree — a symbol of enlightenment and equality. Students observed carved panels depicting the life of Lord Buddha and Dr. Ambedkar. A session at the on-site museum provided deeper insight into the history of the Dalit Buddhist movement. A library visit offered students access to rare texts on Buddhism, constitutional law, and social justice. An interactive talk was delivered by Dr. Subhash Somkuwar, head, Department of Botany, who explained Ambedkar's embrace of Buddhism as a radical act of liberation. This was followed by a Q&A session conducted by Dr. Rahul Kamble.
